Function of the Class


- Teaches the fundamentals of songwriting: lyric writing and storytelling, chord progression development, melody development, song structure
- Teaches basic skills on guitar; could also include piano skills, based on teacher/student preference or popular trends in music of the time
- Teaches basic music theory concepts
- Teaches basic performance skills and etiquette

Seating`



Allows for:

- Students to hear and see everyone easily
- The classroom to function as a social learning community
- Collaborative, jam-sessionlike environment
- Goal of smaller class and even number; 12-14
- May be auditioned, but doesnot have to be





Half 1: Instrument Rotation

- 1st Half of class
- Students practice chords/fingerpicking based on progression of skill benchmarks

-Different Possible Methods:

- Students all must learn guitar techniques at the very least
- Students can choose what instrument to work on at any given time
- Students must learn guitar chords and may choose secondary instrument



Half 1: Instrument Rotation

- Would also include lessons on music theory;
 students would build to a basic understanding of:
 - Key Signatures
 - Time Signatures
 - Diatonic Chords/Types of Chords (major, minor, diminished, augmented)
 - Roman Numeral Analysis
 - Chord Progressions
- This would be embedded into the learning of instrument skills, by having conversations about the chord progressions of popular songs that they will be practicing along to



Half 1: Instrument Rotation

Examples of songs students may play along to or study to understand concepts:

 - "Closure" by Taylor Swift

 - "Little Talks" by Of Monsters and Men
 - I V vi IV:
 - "I'm Yours" by Jason Mraz
 - "Perfect" by P!nk

Example of Half 1 Activity


-In Instrument Rotation, Students Will:

- Be introduced to/review chords, popular chord progressions, popular fingerpicking patterns and strumming rhythms
 - These chords and patterns become progressively more complicated as year continues
 - Progress on ability to play chords consecutively will be assessed by benchmark quizzes


- Look at displayed tablature
 - Students take time to figure our and explore what finger positions feel like
- Practice strumming and switching between chords/picking the pattern in time
 - This can occur along to: a beat track; an accompaniment track; or a popular song that incorporates chords being studied


A Minor

- Performance Days




Example of Half 2 Activity

Structure/Lyric Analysis Worksheet:

- Describe the structure/form of "No Body, No Crime"
- How does the way Taylor Swift has structured her song affect how the story is told?
- Is her story conveyed effectively?Why or why not?
- Use this to inform their own story-song

 - Songs About Societal Experiences/Political Events

 - "Get Up, Stand Up" by Bob Marley and the Wailers


Example of Half 2 Activity

Performance Days

- Students will, after being given a songwriting prompt, will be assigned a date to have it finished and ready to perform for peers
- Sitting in circle, peers will watch each other perform
- Students will fill out peer assessment sheet, filling out a rubric and providing constructive criticism for students to improve their songs, their performance skills, etc.
- Students will fill out a self-reflection sheet, to assess both the quality of their song and of their performance to see how they think the could improve
- With permission, students' performances may be recorded for reflection and review




